

FOREIGN OBJECT DAMAGE (FOD) PREVENTION

REVISION HISTORY

- Revision 3 is the initial revision.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Seller shall ensure items supplied and the packaging will not be a source of debris, Foreign Object Damage (FOD), and/or other contaminants.
2. Seller shall be in compliance with AS9146, FOD Prevention Program, and establish and maintain written FOD Prevention Program Practices to reduce FOD.
 - 2.1. The FOD Prevention Program Practices shall be proportional to the FOD susceptibility of the product(s).
3. The FOD Prevention Program Practices, written procedures, or policies developed by the Seller shall be subject to review and audit by the Buyer and/or government representative(s).

DATA SUBMISSION SUMMARY

- There is no deliverable data to the Buyer required by this document.

- Reviews and audits may be performed at the Seller's facility to ensure effective FOD Prevention Program Practices.
