REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Seller shall ensure items supplied and the packaging will not be a source of Foreign Object Damage (FOD) and/or other contaminants.
- 2. Seller shall establish and maintain written FOD Prevention Program Practices to reduce FOD using National Aerospace Standard 412 (NAS412), as a guideline.
 - 2.1. The FOD Prevention Program Practices shall be proportional to the FOD susceptibility of the product(s).
- 3. The FOD Prevention Program Practices, written procedures, or policies developed by the Seller shall be subject to review and audit by the Buyer and/or government representative(s).
